## JOTA – Registration Package –Introduction, Instructions & Eligibility

### INSTRUCTIONS

1. Write or Print clearly, legibly and neatly!
2. Complete ALL applicable sections and keep a photocopy
3. Attach originals to your Group Committee cheque (or equivalent )

5. You will receive a copy of the registration particulars, together with a receipt for payment while at camp.
6. The designated contact Leader is responsible for ensuring that:
  - Only registered members are enrolled as participants
  - A separate listing of all NON REGISTERED adults who may be assisting you at camp is provided
  - Required screening needs are satisfied for non-registered adults
  - All appropriate policies and procedures of your member organization are upheld and followed
  - All appropriate paperwork for participants in your group is obtained and managed
7. Upon arrival at Mosport, the contact Leader is to provide the JOTA registrar with a **copy** of the completed ***fitness report*** for all Scouting participants (including adults) and the ***H.1/H.2*** for all Guiding participants (including adults) in a sealed envelope along with any outstanding registration forms. First Aid will return the Health/Fitness form copies at the end of camp.
8. All vehicles parked at the Jamboree must have a vehicle registration card placed on the dash filled in. These forms will be made available upon receipt of your completed registration package.
9. Gates open at 3 PM Friday, Oct 16/09. After 5 PM Friday night, at check in you will need to unload your vehicle and equipment must be carried or delivered by JOTA staff trailer to your site to be immediately unloaded.

### ELIGIBILITY

This Jamboree is open to all registered members of WOSM(Scouts Canada) and WAGGGS (Girl Guides of Canada). There is no geographic restriction as to where participants enjoy Scouting/Guiding. Youth participation is for the following age groups and sections:

## 52nd JOTA Camping Notes:

- **NO TRAILERS OF ANY KIND ARE ALLOWED TO REMAIN ON ANY SITE.** After 5 PM Friday night, at check in you will unload your vehicle and equipment must be carried or delivered by JOTA staff trailer to your site to be immediately unloaded. Trailers will be parked in the main parking lot along with all other vehicles.
- Each group is responsible for providing and preparing all meals and snacks for their members. Please bring lots of hand sanitizer!!
- There is a boil water order for the water available on site. Please make provisions for your drinking water
- **NO CAMP FIRES OR COOKING FIRES** of any kind will be allowed. We are in tight quarters and this policy will be strictly enforced.
- There will be a central first aid station on site and the copies of fitness forms and H.1 you have provided will be kept there for emergency purposes. You should maintain a copy for your group on your site as per the policies and procedures of your member organization. These copies will be returned to you at checkout.
- **NO ONE IS ALLOWED ON THE TRACK OR BEYOND THE TRACK BARRIER FENCING!!! EVER!!!**
- Your co-operation with Security, Sub-camp staff and Headquarters staff with regard to rules, curfews, & policies is necessary to ensure the safety and well being of all campers.
- Other than for Ham Radio operations, no generators allowed.
- Other rules and policies will be in your registration confirmation and /or presented at check in and opening.

## JOTA - Group Camp Food Contest: Saturday October 17 2009

Every year we have offered a group challenge contest for groups registered for JOTA. This year we are celebrating the CREATIVE COOKIE BAKEOFF! Each group will be twinned with a group from a different sub camp so make sure to bake enough cookies to share!!

Our Cooking/Food competition is designed to test the culinary and creative skills of the participants!

### CREATIVE COOKIE BAKEOFF CONTEST RULES:

1. Must be made, created and **cooked** at camp by the youth members. Scouts honor!  
(Premade cookie dough is acceptable however the judges have stated they like camp-made better!)
2. **A list of ingredients MUST** accompany the entry for judging.
3. **NO NUTS or PEANUTS** of any kind are to be used!
4. 2 Categories will be judged: Appearance & Edibility/Taste  
PLEASE make sure this is something you would eat – you are expected to share with your twinned group.
5. There should be enough supplied for judging for 2 people to eat.

## JOTA – Flag Pole Building: Sunday October 18, 2009

---

This challenge/contest happens on Sunday before we depart. It is designed to test the ingenuity and group skills of Youth Participants. It should be loads of fun and make for some interesting pictures.

Participating groups are challenged to design and construct a free standing flag pole. The flag pole is to be built by youth and the assembly team composed of participant youth. The rules are very simple and follow..... Get thinking and let's have a great time!

### FLAG POLE DESIGN & CONSTRUCTION RULES:

1. Flag Pole must be "freestanding" with no guy ropes attaching it to the ground in any way.
2. Flag pole must be made of wood, with rope lashing permitted and may not contain any plastic or metal parts  
(yep, wood & rope, that's it)
3. The team must be able to hoist and break a flag to let the colors fly in the wind for the judges
4. You must have fun devising this device!
5. Flag pole may be designed and built prior to the event but must be assembled at JOTA.
6. We depend on our Scouts/Guides honor that the flag pole is built by youth.
7. Three prizes will be awarded for this competition –  
(A) Height – But since it's a race after all, only a specified amount of time will be provided for assembly by the youth  
(B) Design – Ingenuity and creativity and good design deserve recognition too!  
(C) Team Spirit – Costume, Pride, Overall Team appearance and support
8. Practice construction time will be allotted prior to the race – check your itinerary.
9. Decision of the judges will be final.
